Boost the 4D ecosystem by welcoming young talent; give students the opportunity to gain a first professional experience with 4D; enable them to add a 4D reference to their CV to stand out in the developers' community: this is what 4D's cooperation with university institute technologies (IUT) and its partners is all about.

Continuing the momentum of a first partnership with the IUT in Amiens, the partnership that 4D has initiated with the IUT in Saint-Diédes-Vosges is headed for the same success. "In 2017, we offered students 16 internships throu-

ghout France, and in Belgium, Luxembourg and Canada. And three of those students were hired straight after their three-month placement by their host company under permanent or fixed-term contracts" comments Véronique Croizer, IUT partnerships manager at 4D.

Exchange platform

At the start of the academic year, it is her role to centralize internship offers received from partner companies and communicate them to students at IUT Saint-Dié-des-Vosges.

"I gradually receive their applications and, before I forward them to our clients, I contact the students to check their profile and assess their motivations. The company then selects the applicant interns after setting them some tests. We play a connecting role between our partner companies, the university institutes and students."

At the IUT in Saint-Dié-des-Vosges, Véronique Croizer's contact is Emmanuel Medina, a professional contract teacher in the IT department.

Training the developers that communication-enabled businesses need

"The 4D Internet-based training included in our courses prepares the future developers that today's communication-enabled businesses need, i.e. professionals who build bridges between database environments and the Web, says Emmanuel Medina. The internships offered to students pursue the same goals. The feedback from students is really positive. They are satisfied with their experience as it allows them to discover professional applications in the 4D environment. Even though they do not always come away with a job, a three-month end-of-course internship with a 4D partner developer - i.e. with an IT professional - is a fabulous way to learn hands-on and discover the working world, in France or abroad. The worldwide 4D community gives students from Saint-Dié-des-Vosges (a town with 20,000 inhabitants)this great opportunity."

Interns develop real projects

Some interns develop real projects that will be used by their host company. For example, the student who worked in Luxembourg designed a software program to manage the appointments system for a physiotherapy practice. Similarly, Alexandre Ochsenbein, who interned at BSPOKE near Bordeaux, developed from scratch a working-time management application for tablets, for the workers of a construction company. lot about 4D developments, and given my sensibility, I really appreciated the opportunities the platform gave me to create high-quality, modern interfaces. This internship really completed the 4D training I did in my third year at university and the skills I have gained will be a big asset for my future. The reason why BSPOKE founder and Chairman Jean-Michel Biraghi decided to take on an intern is simple. "When I set up my company, it was obvious that I would soon need other people. My goal is to train a team, either by hiring confirmed developers or taking on interns. As I hired a senior developer on a permanent contract last year, this year I wanted to hire a junior. There were a number of possible solutions: a graduate, an intern or a student

on a work-study contract. When 4D came to us with their internship program, I jumped at the opportunity."

Ability to learn: a criterion for recruitment

Jean-Michel chose Alexandre after an interview and a few programming tests. "Of all the applicants we interviewed, he was the one who seemed to know the most and have the best ability to learn. He was also motivated and enthusiastic, something we had already seen by talking to him on Skype. We really hit it off. Through this experience, Alexandre showed us that he was able to learn - a vital aspect for a developer - and fit into the team. He was very dedicated and adopted our practices and our ways of working. He quickly understood our clients' needs and, thanks to what he had learned at university and then in our studio, he was able to develop projects. In this respect, it was definitely a success!

Even though, in the end, Alexandre is not staying with the company, he is leaving us with more experience and expertise than he had when he arrived and, therefore, with more " appeal" for the 4D development market. By training him, I feel I have made my contribution and helped to promote the 4D environment in the academic and economic world."

About IUT of St-Diédes-Vosges

The IUT Saint-Dié-des-Vosges is a component of the University of Lorraine. Its IT Department trains applications developers in three streams breaking down as follows in 2017/2018:

- Two-year diploma (DUT) in Computing: 95 students (52 in the first year and 43 in the second).
- Professional degree in ";Internet and Mobile Media (I2M)": 18 students.
- Professional degree in "Sound and Image Techniques - 3D Computer Graphics": 17 students.

Students on the DUT in Computing and the 12M degree course attend approximately 30 hours of lessons on the 4D environment and databases.

For the 2018/2019 academic year, the I2M degree course is becoming AMIO (Mobile Applications and Internet of Things), and will include more programming. And the second degree course is renamed IG3D (3D Computer Graphics).
